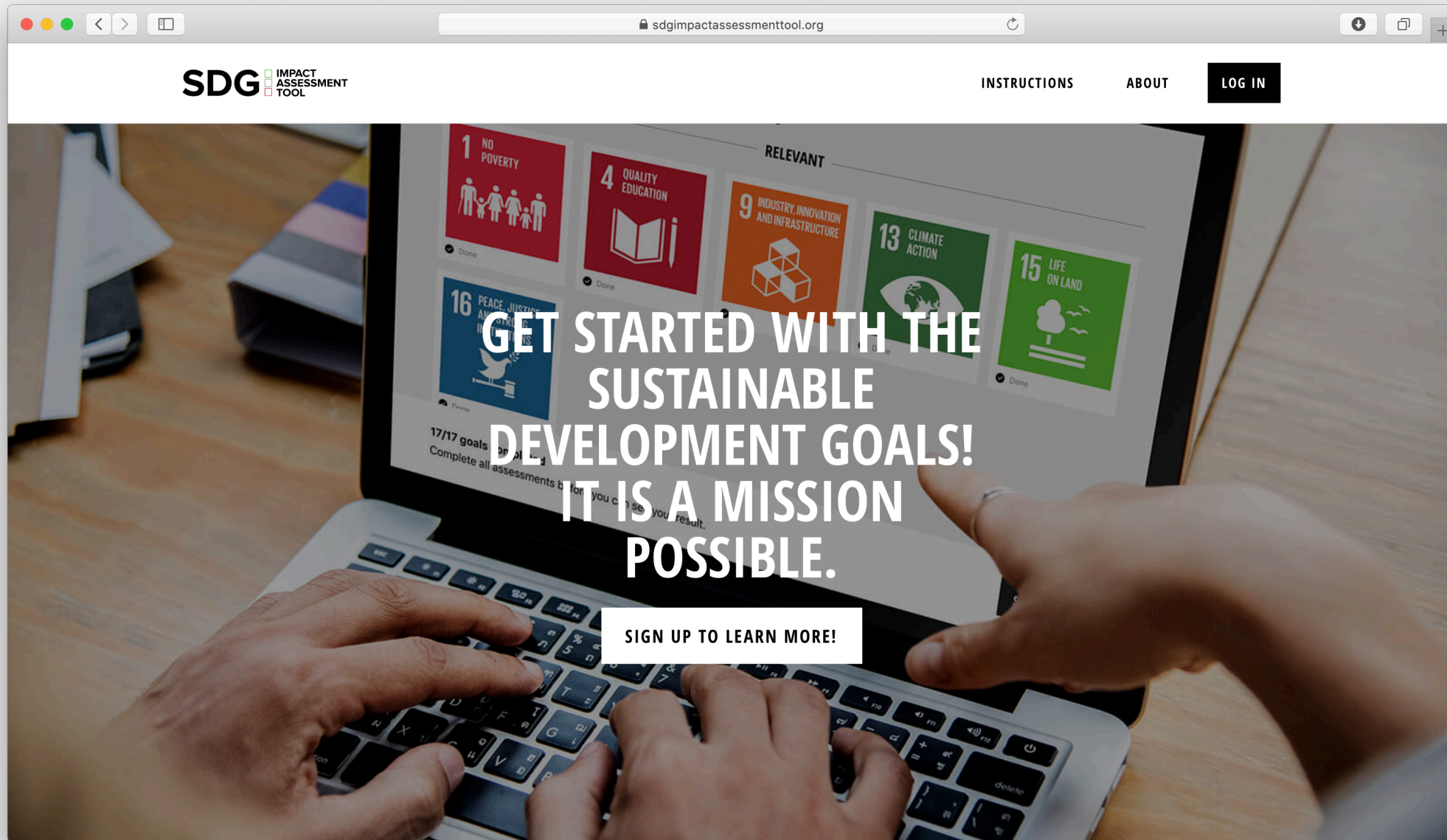

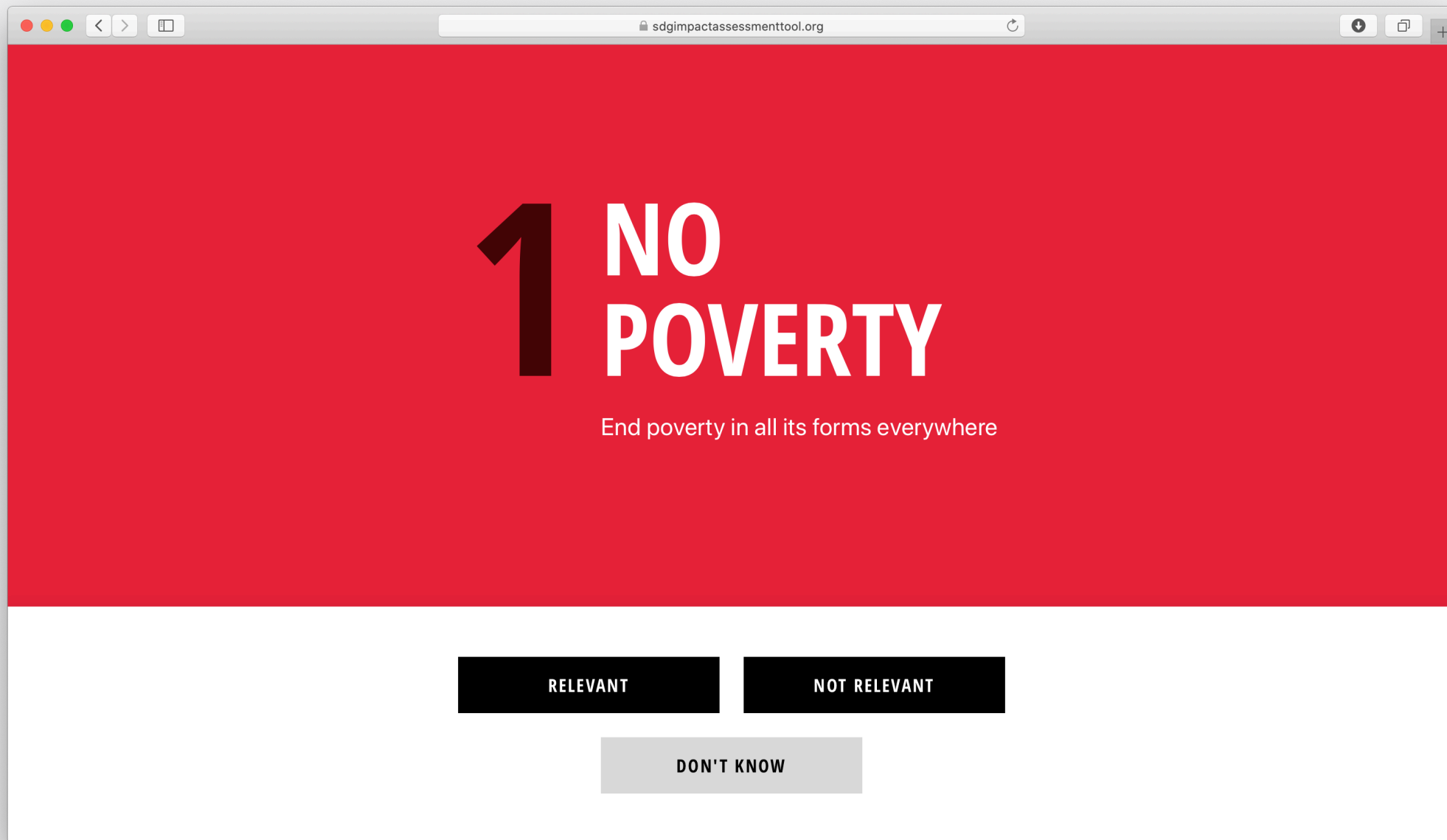

TARGET 1-1



Eradicate extreme poverty

By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere, currently measured as people living on less than \$1.25 a day.


TARGET 1-2



Reduce poverty by at least 50%

By 2030, reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions.


TARGET 1-3



Implement social protection systems

Implement nationally appropriate social protection systems and measures for all, including floors, and by 2030 achieve substantial coverage of the poor and the vulnerable.


TARGET 1-4



Equal rights to ownership, basic services, technology and economic resources


By 2030, ensure that all men and women, in particular the poor and the vulnerable, have equal rights to economic resources, as well as access to basic services, ownership and control over land and other forms of property, inheritance, natural resources, appropriate new technology and financial services, including microfinance.

- People easily become excluded from working and public life if they lack proper documentation of their education.
- Validation of prior learning thus provides a way of breaking down structures that keep people in poverty.



- Validation provides access to further education for those who lack documentation of prior education, whether formal, informal or non-formal.
- Contributes to life-long learning and participation in working and public life



- Validation is becoming increasingly important with increased rate of change in labour markets
- Recognition of prior learning provides access to further education and allows greater efficiency in meeting labour needs

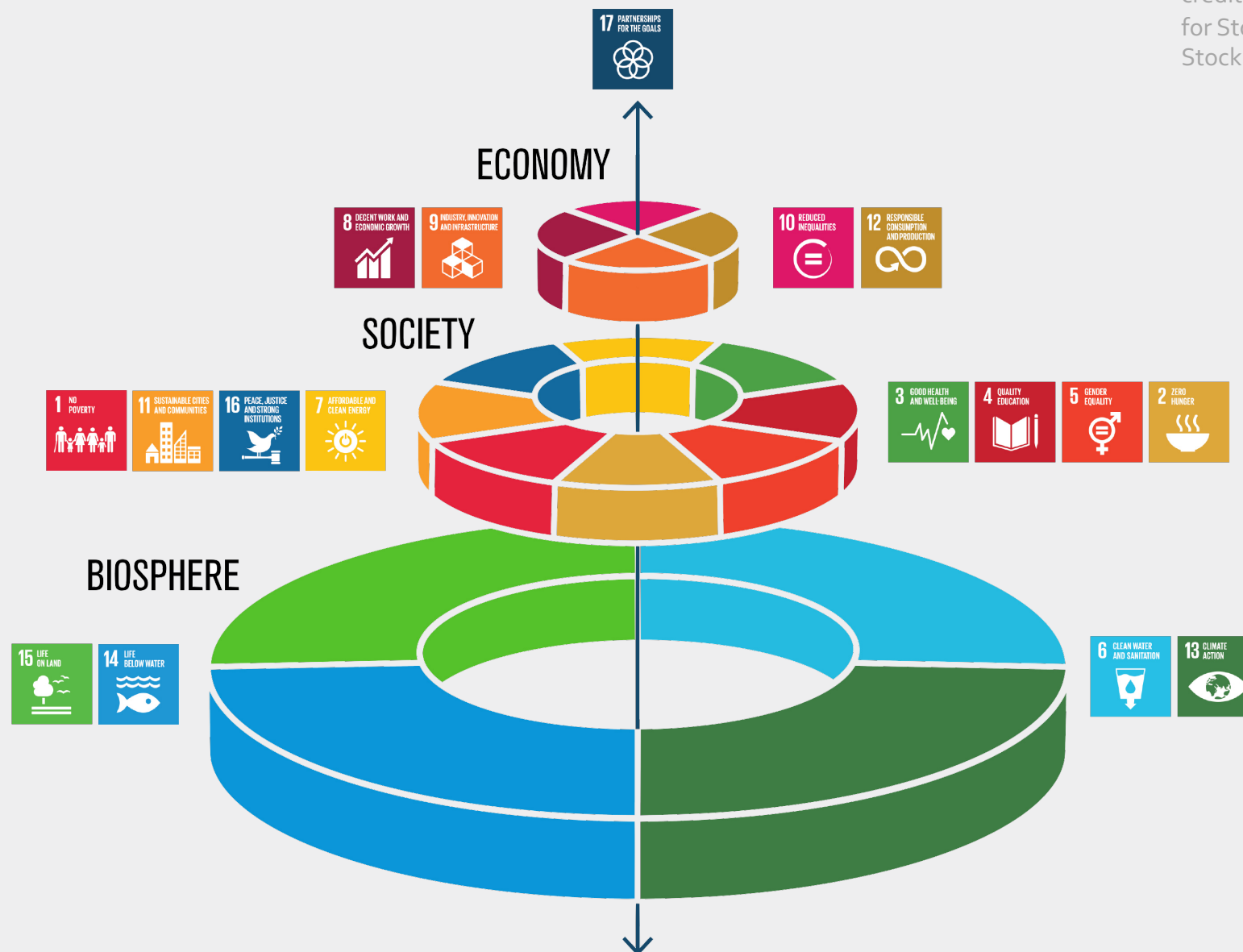
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Feedback: Good

- Tool was easy to use
- Got us reflecting on the SDGs in relation to our work

Feedback: Bad

- Lack of definitions, explanations (especially: direct, indirect, impact)
- Too general: not specifically about what NVL networks can contribute
- Premise not clear: focus on some SDGs or all?
- Too technical: “ticking boxes”
- Would have liked relevant examples of impact

Feedback: Discussions?

- Difference between direct and indirect impact.
- What does it mean to have an impact?
- Realistically, what can our network contribute?
- What is the relevance, for networks working in the Nordics, of global goals that mainly apply to poorer parts of the world?
