Established by the Nordic Council of Ministers, the Nordic Network for Lifelong Learning (NLL) provides a central platform for cooperation on lifelong learning, fostering knowledge-sharing and innovation across the Nordic region. NLL creates solutions that enhance skills, employability and inclusion in the Nordic societies.

The cooperation between Nordplus and NLL works on ensuring that the results and experiences from Nordplus projects are highlighted and used to support the development of Nordic education systems. NLL and Nordplus Adult cooperation is important for enhancing participation in lifelong learning.

Impact and synergies



The goals of NLL and Nordplus Adult align on multiple levels, creating synergies that:

- promote innovative educational practices and inclusive learning opportunities,
- develop skills that are essential to prepare individuals for the future labour market,
- explore digital methods which support adult learning,
- support the development of the guidance and validation systems essential for increasing the participation in lifelong learning,
- promote the integration of sustainability into lifelong learning.

The benefits of working together



The collaboration between NLL and Nordplus has exciting potential of increasing the benefits for organisations and institutions from the education system and working life and thereby strengthening the Nordic – Baltic lifelong learning area.

- Working together, both programmes can identify clusters of projects among active initiatives, fostering deeper knowledge exchange and potential scaling of results.
- New potential areas for further development work can be identified collaboratively building on the existing results.
- Through collaboration NLL and Nordplus projects can reach a broader and more diverse group of stakeholders and thus increase the relevance for, and inclusion of, the target groups.
- Dissemination beyond the project consortium and NLL networks can be achieved.
